## **How Do I Arrange for Chore Corps?**



**Call our toll free number:** 1-877-711-7787. Staff will talk with you about your needs, priorities, and resources. We will try to match you with a volunteer from your area, who has the appropriate skills.



**If available, a volunteer will call** you and arrange to come out and assess the situation, measure it up if needed, or do the work then.

**Home-owners must pay for materials** - - we have no funding for that.



**Some requests may be beyond the scope of Chore Corps,** including situations requiring licensed contractors. We do not offer ongoing maintenance services such as plowing or lawn mowing.

**Staff will follow up with you** to see if the volunteer was helpful.



**Chore Corps is not an emergency service.** We need about one week notice to contact volunteers and to give them time to contact you.

**Chore Corps volunteers donate their time and labor** so there are no fees, but we do welcome donations to ensure the availability of a helping hand for you or someone else in the future.
