

911 Addresses

The purpose of having a 911 address is to promote public health and safety by means of providing a permanent identification of residential, multifamily and commercial structures within the town.

The objective of having a visible 911 number is to provide a means for expedient response by police, fire and EMS as well as serving as a mail delivery address, and for utilities, and other delivery services.

We ask that you please display your 911 number as follows:

Numbers shall be 3 inches in height and with a reflective background.

Structures visible from the road: Where the structure is visible from the road and at such a distance that the numbers are legible from the road itself, the number shall be affixed to the structure in a place that clearly identifies it.

Structures not visible from the road: Where a structure is not visible from the road or is otherwise situated to make the number display on the structure ineffective, the number shall be displayed at the access entrance or driveway at the roadway itself, and we also then encourage it to be on the structure as well.

Mailboxes: If your mailbox is on the same side of the road as your structure, you should place the 911 number on both sides of the mailbox. If your mailbox is across the street from your structure you should affix the number to the front of the mailbox only.

Regardless of where your mailbox is, please adhere to the above two guidelines. This will help us, help you in the event of an emergency
