UPCOMING AND ONGOING ENVIROMENTAL SURVEY WORK

Dear Neighbor:

Starting in the October and continuing through December, New England Power (NEP) and its contractors will be conducting environmental survey work in and around the existing New England Power transmission right-of-way between Monroe and Londonderry, NH. The data collected will be utilized to inform the interconnection upgrade as a result of the proposed Granite State Power Link project co-developed by National Grid and Citizens Energy (www.GraniteStatePowerLink.com).

Vanasse Hangen Brustlin Inc (VHB) is NEP's authorized contractor and will conduct the survey work throughout the existing NEP right-of-way (approximately 109 miles) where permissions currently exist and/or site access has been obtained.

VHB field survey crews will access the NEP transmission corridor from existing access roads and points throughout and adjacent to the power line corridor. Crews will have identification and further information about this work. As they conduct the survey work, you may see environmental flagging and GPS work near wetlands and streams, and targeted surveys for rare, threatened or endangered species and historic properties. All survey work will be non-invasive. Although we anticipate the work to continue throughout the remainder of the fall of 2017, some surveys will not be completed until next spring.
